Dr. Scott D. Miller is President of Virginia Wesleyan University, Coastal Virginia's premier university of the liberal arts and sciences located in Virginia Beach, Virginia. Respected as one of the most entrepreneurial higher education executives in America, Dr. Miller is in his 31st year as a college president. He has dedicated his career to the opportunities available through education and especially values the small, classical, church-related liberal arts college environment that offers students personalized pathways to life and career success.

Previously, he was President of Bethany College (2007-2015), Wesley College (1997-2007), and Lincoln Memorial University (1991-97). At LMU, he was just 31 years old at the time of appointment, the youngest college president in the nation.

He has authored or edited 16 books and over 200 professional articles. For many years was a regular columnist for College Planning and Management, Huffington Post, Enrollment Manager, and The Virginian-Pilot. For 16 years he served as the Executive Editor of President to President, a national thought series for college and university presidents internationally.

A lifelong member of the United Methodist Church, Dr. Miller has served as President and Chair of the Board of Directors of the North American Association of Methodist Colleges and Universities (NAAMSCU), President and Chair of the Board of Directors of the Council of Colleges and Universities of the Christian Church – Disciples of Christ (CCUCC) and was Chair of the Association of Educational Institutions of the Virginia Conference of the United Methodist Church.
