SENSE OF PURPOSE

SERVICE LEARNING


Address real-world problems in a service experience locally, regionally, or abroad.

HONORS CAPSTONE

The Batten Honors College academic program culminates with an Honors Capstone course. Scholars will be encouraged to reflect on their academic, cultural, social, and service experience as part of the program and integrate their experiences, skills, and knowledge into individual or team projects.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Students admitted into the Batten Honors College will be awarded either a full-tuition Batten Fellowship or a two-thirds tuition Schumadine Scholarship. Twenty scholarships of each amount will be awarded every year. Additional need-based financial aid is also available to those students who qualify.

OUR LOCATION

Virginia Wesleyan is Coastal Virginia's premier university of the liberal arts and sciences. Our 300-acre park-like campus is located in Virginia Beach, just minutes away from the Atlantic Ocean and the Chesapeake Bay.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission to the Batten Honors College is highly selective. Consideration will be given to applicants for freshman admission with the following qualifications:

- High school grade point average equal to or greater than 3.5
- in combination with either:*
- ACT score equal to or greater than 27
 - or
 - SAT score equal to or greater than 1300 (*test taken March 2016 and later*)

APPLICATION PROCESS

The application process requires submission of the following:

- Application for admission to Virginia Wesleyan University
- Batten Honors College application, which includes short answer questions and an essay
- Letter of recommendation
- Resume
- On-campus interview

The Batten Honors College review process is holistic, and applicants who are deemed admissible on the basis of academic performance, essay, and evidence of service and extracurricular activities will be invited to participate in an on-campus interview competition.
