B. High School Completion Status

Provide one of the following documents that will indicate the student's high school completion status when the student begins college in 2020-2021:

I have attached the following document to this worksheet (check 1 box):

A copy of the student's high school diploma.

A copy of the student's final and official high school transcript that shows the date when the diploma was awarded.

A state certificate or transcript received by a student after the student passed a state-authorized examination (GED test, HiSET, TASC, or other state-authorized exam) that the state recognizes as the equivalent of a high school diploma.

For students who completed secondary education in a foreign country, a copy of the "secondary school leaving certificate" or other similar document.

An academic transcript that indicates the student successfully completed at least a two-year program that is acceptable for full credit toward a bachelor's degree.

For a homeschooled student in a State where State law requires the the student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a copy of that credential.

For a homeschooled student from a State where State law does not require the student to obtain a secondary school completion credential for homeschool (other than a high school diploma or its recognized equivalent), a transcript or the equivalent, signed by the student's parent or guardian, that lists the secondary school courses the student completed and includes a statement that the student successfully completed a secondary school education in a homeschool setting.

C. Identity and Statement of Educational Purpose (this section is ONLY to be completed in person at VWU or in front of a Notary).

The student must appear in person at Virginia Wesleyan University to verify his or her identity by presenting a valid, government-issued photo identification (ID), such as, but not limited to, a driver's license, other state-issued ID, or passport. VWU will maintain a copy of the student's photo ID that is annotated with the date it was received and the name of the official at VWU authorized to collect the student's ID.

Additionally, the student must sign, in the presence of the institutional official, the Statement of Education Purpose provided below. *If you cannot appear in person to sign this Statement of Educational Purpose, you will need to provide a copy of your government issued ID and this Statement of Educational Purpose notarized by a public notary.*
