


WINTER & SUMMER SESSIONS





APPLICATION CHECKLIST

- Complete and sign application
- Submit transcripts (high school and/or previous college)
- Submit official copy of ACT or SAT scores (freshman applicants)
- Complete the federal financial aid application (FAFSA) after October 1. The FAFSA form can be found online at fafsa.ed.gov (School Code: 003767).
